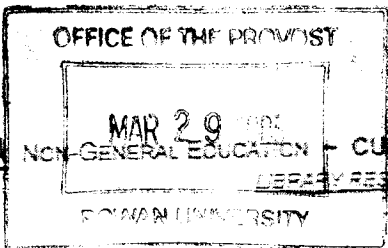

RATIONALE:

- a. Statement of need:

The Graduate Program in Music calls for 2 semesters of Ensemble Experience (suitable to specialization). To fulfill this requirement each of our MM students must participate in a "Major Ensemble". The "Major Ensembles" are Wind Ensemble, Orchestra, Concert Choir, Lab Band, and Jazz Band. However none of them have Graduate Level HEGIS numbers and neither the Graduate School nor NASM (our national accreditation body) will accept these credits if they are listed as undergraduate.

I believe that the lack of Graduate Level HEGIS numbers for Wind Ensemble, Orchestra, Jazz Band, Lab Band, and Concert Choir was an just an oversight and this proposal is an attempt to correct that mistake.
