2. Rational

As part of the changes involved in the Department's participation in the Association of American Colleges Reforming the Major Project, the intent is to make this theory course (Intermediate Macroeconomics) more accessible to nonmajors. The thought is that someone who has passed only the 2204.101 An Introduction to Economics-A Macroeconomic Perspective course should have access to the intermediate course. Since fundamentals of the market are taught in both the 2204.101 An Introduction to Economics-A Macroeconomic Perspective and 2204.102 An Introduction to Economics-A Microeconomic Perspective courses, the introductory microeconomics course (2204.102) provides no additional necessary background for successful completion of the Intermediate Macroeconomics course. Consequently, a student who has passed only the introductory macroeconomics course (2204.101) should be allowed to enroll in the course.
