

CURRICULUM PROPOSAL

Proposal for Change in Name for Introduction to Computer Science

1. Details

- a. Change Requested: Change course name from "Introduction to Computer Science" to "Introduction to Programming".
- b. Sponsor: Don Stone, Department of Mathematics and Computer Science.

2. Rationale

- a. The current name of this course is a source of some confusion, since the course currently focuses on computer programming (in the BASIC language) and covers other aspects of Computer Science in less depth. Some of the material on the history and applications of computers which had been covered in this course is now covered in the course Computer Literacy.
- b. This change will have little curricular effect.
