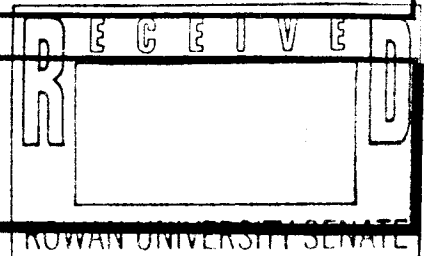

**CHANGE IN MIS SPECIALIZATION**

**DETAILS**

- A. Changes Requested:
- Add required course: E-Business – Information Systems Perspective (new course)
  - Add required course: Advanced Database Management (new course) 0702.340
  - Delete required course: 0702.340 – Decision Support Systems (*while this course will no longer be required, it can be chosen as a restricted elective*)
  - Delete required course: 0506.304 - Organizational Change & Development (*while this course will no longer be required, it can be chosen as a restricted elective*)
- B. Sponsor: Diane Hamilton, Department of Management & MIS

**RATIONALE**

- A. Over time the MIS specialization needs to be updated to reflect current theory and practice. This change is submitted in order to make MIS students more valuable to business in the areas that account for the highest employer demand, specifically database management and electronic commerce.
- B. This change will make the program significantly stronger without requiring any additional resources. Within the department, one required course will be substituted for another. The two courses no longer required will be added to the list of “restricted electives for MIS students” and offered as faculty availability allows.
