## Minor curriculum change proposal

### Prerequisite change

#### 1. Details

- a. Change prerequisite codes **from:** a nonexistent course number (0506.303)

**to:** Principles of Management (0506.203)

for the following courses:

Management of Human Resources (0506.302), Organization Change and Development (0506.304), Operations Management (0506.305), Managing Services (0506.375), Business Policy (0506.402), Business Management Simulation (0506.405), Labor/Employee Relations (0516.401), and Physical Distribution (0509.375).

- b. Sponsors:     Joel Rudin, Department of Management/MIS

#### 2. Rationale

- a. A nonexistent course number (0506.303) is shown as a prerequisite for these seven courses. The course number should be (0506.203), Principles of Management.
- b. There is no curricular effect on our department. This change affects one course taught by the Marketing department (0509.375, Physical Distribution), which also has the nonexistent course code as its prerequisite. This change will reduce confusion among all students who seek to complete graduation requirements in the College of Business, for which Business Policy and Operations Management are required courses.

#### 3. Results of Consultation

This proposal was discussed with the chair of the Department of Management/MIS.
