Subj: Request to Delete Two Courses

We would appreciate approval to delete the following two courses:

- ▷ 0506.307 Managerial Planning and Control ◀
- ▷ 0506.308 Values in Managerial Decision Making

The Values course is no longer needed because the Philosophy Department now teaches a course in Business Ethics. We had originally set up the Values course because of the prominent role ethical questions have come to assume in modern management. However, about a year ago the Philosophy Department agreed to set up an ethics course focussing on these same issues. That course has proved successful and two sections a semester now operate. The feedback from all concerned has been most satisfactory. Our course, therefore, is no longer needed and should be officially deleted.

We also feel we no longer need a course focussing on the management functions of planning and controlling. This course was set up several years ago to meet our concern that we were not sufficiently exposing our students to these two key managerial concerns. However, as our faculty and course offerings have developed we have been able to thoroughly incorporate planning and controlling in our teaching of management topics. These functions, for instance, are well covered in such courses as those dealing with small business operations, personnel management, marketing and management science. The practical result has been a growing overlap between these courses and the planning course. Furthermore, teaching planning and controlling within the context of management topics such as these is a sounder approach because that's how these functions are encountered in the "real" world. In short, our offerings have developed to the point where the planning course is no longer needed and we wish to delete it.

In due course I ^{would} appreciate "official" confirmation that these courses have been deleted.


