To 1502.117  
Masterpieces of World Literature II  
Designed to give the student some knowledge of and sensitivity toward our literary heritage from all around the world, the course covers a limited number of works not written in English and composed after the birth of Christ. Emphasis is placed upon perceptions, beliefs, and values that are different from modern American perceptions, beliefs, and values, and what the student can gain from a recognition of such differences.

This new description accurately describes the content, the chronological division, and the emphasis of the course as it is presently taught.
