Major selected literary works are studied. The first part covers literary works through the Renaissance; the second, from the Enlightenment to the present. Either part may be taken separately.

Masterpieces of World Literature I
Designed to give the student some knowledge of and sensitivity toward our heritage from ancient cultures all around the world, the course covers a limited number of works not written in English and composed before the birth of Christ. Emphasis is placed upon the perceptions, beliefs, and values that are different from modern American perceptions, beliefs, and values, and what the student can gain from a recognition of such differences.

This new description accurately describes the content, the chronological division, and the emphasis of the course as it is presently taught.
