I. Title: Mythology

II. Essence

1. Undergraduate
2. 3 semester hours credit
3. Elective--all classes
4. No prerequisites
5. Unrestricted general education elective
6. Spring Semester 1974--1 or 2 sections

III. Other details

1. Present staff adequate, no special resources required
2. Current library holdings adequate
3. No space needs other than classrooms
4. No similar course exists
5. Objective: general knowledge of the mythological backgrounds of Western Culture and the persistence of mythological motifs in art and literature

IV. Rationale:

Few areas of study are more legitimately recognized as essential to the student of arts and science. The lack of such a course has been a deficiency in our program, and its inclusion an important step towards the enrichment of many programs in arts and sciences.
