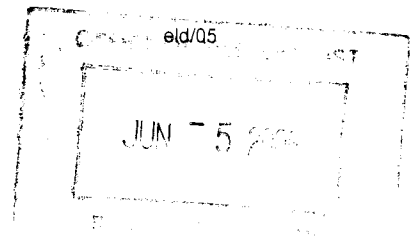

DETAILS

a. Change requested: Prerequisite change for Newspaper Feature Writing (JRN 02312)

From News Reporting I (JRN 02310)

To News Reporting II (JRN 02311)

b. Sponsor: Kathryn Quigley, Assistant Professor, Journalism

RATIONALE

a. Need for change: News Reporting 1 and News Reporting 2 are skills classes. Requiring students to master certain journalism skills will enable them to concentrate more fully on the craft of newspaper feature writing. They will be able to focus more on narrative structure, dialogue and scene description of events.

b. Curricular effect: Having both News Reporting I and II will prepare students better for this course.
