## Minor Curricular Change Proposal

**Course Title: Philosophy and Gender**  
**Department: Philosophy and Religion**

### Details

- a. Change current course number of Philosophy and Gender **1509.129** (W/I and M/G) to **1509.329**. Change Philosophy and Gender **1509.128** to **1509.328** (M/G)

### Rationale

- a. The current Philosophy and Gender course regularly offered in our department is the Writing Intensive course. This course is not open to students who have not taken Composition I and II (or a suitable replacement). So, this course is not an entry-level course and should not be a 100 level course. We do not foresee offering the non-writing intensive version of this course in the future. Still, the course number should be raised in order to reflect the nature of the course material. The course covers feminist theories and critiques of philosophical thought that are not entry-level material. Since our department offers the Writing Intensive Philosophy and Gender course annually, we are most concerned with changing its Hegis number to match the actual requirements for the course.
- b. The American Studies Program would like to add Philosophy and Gender as a bank selection. This program does not allow “100” level courses for the major. If we change Philosophy and Gender to a “300” level course, this will benefit American Studies students.
- c. This change will have a positive effect for Rowan University students. Students will understand that **1509.329** is a Writing Intensive course that is not for first –year students. This change will not impact any other program or department.
