As per our discussion, I am requesting that the admission requirements for the Post-baccalaureate Achievement Certificates in Athletic Administration and Coaching be the following:

1. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in any major.
2. Minimum 2.5 overall undergraduate grade point average.
3. Minimum 2.8 during last 60 semester hours of undergraduate work.
4. Appropriate letter of recommendation.
5. Interview with program advisor.

The Department of Health and Physical Education is not requiring an undergraduate major in health and physical education or teaching certification in same. This was unclear in the original proposal for these achievement certificates.
