2. Rationale

- a. Statement of Need: The previous requirement for this course was Synecology (0420.594). We have changed the name of the Synecology course to Advanced Ecology to better serve graduate students by providing them with a more accurate sense of this course's primary focus. We also feel that the ecological concepts covered in the undergraduate course Ecology (0420.310) are sufficient for students to engage in the specifics of Pine Barrens Ecology. Therefore, we want Ecology or Advanced Ecology to be the pre-requisite for Pine Barrens Ecology.
- b. Statement of Curricular Effect: The purpose of the prerequisite change is to provide graduate students with a greater flexibility of options for the ecological concepts covered in this course. This prerequisite change will serve this purpose.
