2. RATIONALE

a. Statement of "need":

The largest majority of Business Administration students come to Glassboro State College with some previous background in programming. Pascal, as a programming language, offers much more to the student regarding the theory of programming than does a course in BASIC. Pascal was designed to promote structured, readable programs and offers many more complex data structures than does BASIC. The Computer Science department has been using Pascal as the first programming course in their sequence, and we propose to do the same.

b. Statement of curricular effect:

The effect of this proposal on the curriculum would be to require students to take the course Structured Programming in Pascal. A proposal to change the MIS specialization (to include this course) is concurrently being submitted.

3. RESULTS OF CONSULTATION

a. All faculty within the Management Department were consulted regarding this proposal. The proposal was approved at a regular Management Department faculty meeting.
