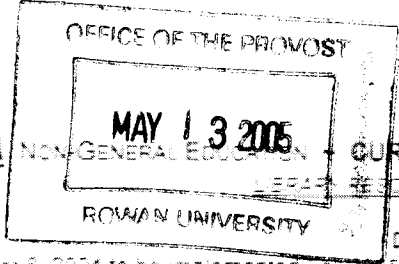

Minor Curriculum Change to an Existing (Non-General Education) Course

Details

Course title: Selected Topics for School Leadership (0827.505)

Sponsors: Profs. Doolittle, Hespe, and Monahan (for the Faculty of the Educational Leadership Department)

Rationale for the Minor Curriculum Change

Need: In the recently changed M.A. program in School Administration, there is a need for a variable topics, variable credit course. At present, this course is a variable topics course, but it is fixed at 3 s.h. We propose to revise this fixed credit structure to add flexibility.

Curricular Effect: We do not propose any changes to this course other than changing the credit hours from 3 s.h. to variable credit 1-6 s.h. This will provide for much-needed flexibility for our master's programs in school administration

Changes: We propose only one change, as follows:

FROM: 3 s.h.

TO: Variable credit 1-6 s.h.

Results of Consultations
