DETAILS

A. Change Requested:

Change the course description for 0504.424 Seminar in Finance

From: A seminar course providing a broad overview of contemporary issues in finance. The course seeks to understand the underlying financial economics rationale that shapes the contemporary events and issues. Curricular contents will be regularly updated to include contemporaneous trends in the industry.

To: Having learned financial markets, financial management, and investment/portfolio analysis in previous finance courses, in this course, students will undertake integrative research on these subjects. This course will teach students the skills required to undertake independent research. They will select a topic, conduct a literature review, and collect and analyze data.

RATIONALE

The current course description is not clearly explaining the content and objective of the course. This is a senior-level course. It assumes a given level of knowledge students have acquired from previous finance courses. Based on this knowledge, students will learn the skills and techniques of independent research in this course, and they will conduct an integrative research by reviewing the literature, collecting and analyzing the relevant data.
