B. Sponsor: Diane Hamilton, Department of Management & MIS

RATIONALE

- A. Changes in program requirements, enacted during the previous academic year, as well as future course scheduling, where most specialization courses will be offered only one time each year, necessitate this change in prerequisites, which requires that students delay this course until their senior year. Since this course will be offered during the spring semester only, the great majority of students will be in their final semester when enrolled in this course. This is important for instructional reasons as well as assessment reasons. The specialization assessment for MIS will be administered each year within this course.
