The Department of History wishes to change a course title from 2205 455 Sex in History to 2205 455 Sex and Gender in History. The proposed change would reflect more accurately what is being taught in the course. The course is involved with sexual behavior and gender relationships that involve masculine and feminine identity within historical time frames.

The catalog description would read as follows:

2205.455

Sex and Gender in History

3 cr.

(Prerequisites: 2205.100 and 2205.101)

This course approaches the study of human sexual behavior from an historical point of view; i.e., how attitudes towards sex and gender behavior have varied over the centuries. The historical laboratory for the course will be the world of Western Civilization. A major research paper is required.
