SUBJECT: Proposed change of course requirements for English Majors

DATE: April 2, 1978

The English Department under review has received the number of semester hours required for a major in English from 30 s.h. to 36 s.h. The two additional semester hours to be required of English majors are Senior III and Junior III literature, 1855-1915. Both of these courses are presently designated

Rationale: The inclusion of the above mentioned courses among those required for graduation with a B.A. in English would provide stronger preparation in writing and American literature than most students will receive.
