Date: February 23, 1998

The College of Engineering requests that Sophomore Engineering Clinic I be changed from 3 credits to 4 credits. Neither the objectives nor outline for the courses have changed. The elements in College Communication II (1501.112) have been integrated into the course structure. The change reflects the partnership with the College of Communication faculty to impart a strong communication foundation to our students. The number of contact hours for the course is consistent with the proposed 4 credit designation.

Considerable discussion by the faculty in each of the engineering programs led to this change. The new, and approved, curriculum in each engineering program reflects this change.

As noted on the MINOR CURRICULAR CHANGE FORM, we request that the HEGIS number be changed to 0901.201. This reflects a more proper numerical sequencing for the course within each engineering program.
