Books and Supplies	May vary dramatically by year; we recommend you set aside \$1,500 - \$2,000 for books and supplies.	
Transportation	Cost of transportation will vary depending on distance to be traveled. Most students who reside on our properties have minimal transportation expense while students who commute have substantially larger expense. Please consider student teaching, long commutes and internships.	
Other Expenses	Consider personal expenses such as clothing, bedding, laundry, entertainment, etc.
