

## **Financial Obligations**

The University may deny a student graduation, readmission, registration or records because of outstanding financial obligations to the University. This action may be taken in cases where the student has been given reasonable notice of a debt and consequences of non-payment. Students who do not meet their outstanding obligations by established deadlines under this policy will automatically be denied registration for the following semester, in addition to losing all other University services. Denial of future semesters will be continued until such time as the obligation is met. The student has the right to a hearing in cases of dispute concerning an obligation. The request for a hearing must be submitted in writing by the student to the appropriate department or office head in which the obligation exists. That department or office will then work with the Collections Department of the Business Office.
