

## **Senior Privilege**

Seniors at Rowan University who have at least a 3.0 GPA may request permission from the Graduate School director to register for one graduate level course per semester. The total number of graduate credits taken shall not exceed 6 semester hours. Students may take a graduate course for application to an undergraduate degree, and the courses may apply to the graduate program at Rowan upon approval of the graduate program advisor. For a student to enroll in a graduate course, recommendations are required from both the student's undergraduate program advisor and the chairperson of the department(s) in which the graduate course(s) is/are housed. Furthermore, the final approval for exceptions to the policy must also be obtained from the director of the Graduate School.
