Criteria for Evaluation

1. **What is the maximum number of transfer credits accepted?**
 - a) **Total transfer credits allowed from a 4-year college- 90 s.h.**
Total transfer credits allowed from a 2-year college- 70 s.h.
 - b) **Do you accept credits from non-accredited or Nationally accredited institutions? No.**
(Generally, Rowan recognizes regional accreditation) Limitations? No.
2. **What is the maximum number of semester hours accepted toward the major requirements? Case-by-case analysis. Approximately 20 s.h. may be applied as General Education.**
3. **What is the maximum age for external credits accepted towards your program? 10 years for major courses; Case-by-case for General Education.**
4. **Are "D" grades accepted in major course work? No.**

In non-major courses/Gen Ed's? No.
5. **Are P/NC grades accepted in major coursework? No. Yes for Free Electives only.**
6. **Are 300 level courses transferrable? Case-by-case review.**
7. **What is the total number of credits required for graduation? 120 s.h.**
8. **How many credits in the major must be completed at Rowan to graduate? N/A.**
9. **What courses, grades, and GPA are needed before applying to the major? A 2.3 overall GPA is required by the major. No specific courses required to apply to the program.**
10. **Three credit (3 s.h.) Lab Science courses DO NOT fulfill the lab science requirement. 4 s.h. courses are needed.**
11. **What are Non-Program Courses in this program? Non-program courses in American Studies number 12 – 14 s.h. There are no specific requirements. They are listed in the new program guide only as "choice." These are college-level, non-remedial courses.**
