Criteria for Evaluation

1. **What is the maximum number of transfer credits accepted?** 90
 - a) **Total transfer credits allowed from a 4-year college-** 90
Total transfer credits allowed from a 2-year college- 90
 - b) **Do you accept credits from non-accredited or Nationally accredited institutions? (Generally, Rowan recognizes regional accreditation) Limitations?**
Credits that are consistent with Rowan standards will be accepted.
2. **What is the maximum number of semester hours accepted toward the major requirements?**
A total of 6 credits will be accepted in the major. They can be counted under "required courses" and/or "related electives." All other courses are accepted under General Education courses or Free Elective courses.
3. **What is the maximum age for external credits accepted towards your program?** None -- this is on a case-by-case basis.
4. **Are "D" grades accepted in major course work?** No

In non-major courses/Gen Ed's? Yes
5. **Are there exceptions: (i.e., a grade of "C" or better in courses which require the "D" course as a pre-requisite, or a C or higher in the last of a course sequence, i.e., Bio I (D), Bio II (D), Bio III (A)- from Quarter System?** No
6. **What are the requirements for acceptable major courses as identified on the program guide?**
At least a "C minus" in major courses; 2.5 GPA in major and 2.0 GPA overall to graduate
7. **Will an occasional C will be accepted if the GPA is maintained at a 2.500 minimum?** Yes
8. **Are P/NC grades accepted in major coursework?** No
9. **Are 300 level courses transferrable?** Yes
10. **What is the total number of credits required for graduation?** 120-121
11. **How many credits in the major must be completed at Rowan to graduate?** 33 minimum
