Criteria for Evaluation

1. **What is the maximum number of transfer credits accepted?** 90
 - a) **Total transfer credits allowed from a 4-year college-** 90
Total transfer credits allowed from a 2-year college- number may depend upon choice of LSHSS Program Sequences
 - b) **Do you accept credits from non-accredited or Nationally accredited institutions? (Generally, Rowan recognizes regional accreditation) Limitations?**
Must be evaluated on case by case basis
 - c) **Are courses accredited by the National League for Nursing automatically accepted?** Nursing credits can count only for Free Electives or Non-Program credit in the LSHSS major
2. **What is the maximum number of semester hours accepted toward the major requirements?**
Dependent upon choice of LSHSS Program Sequences
3. **What is the maximum age for external credits accepted towards your program?**
Dependent upon choice of LSHSS Program Sequences
4. **Are "D" grades accepted in major course work?** Yes, with the exception of the Applied Spanish LSHSS Program Sequence that requires minimum grade of C-

In non-major courses/Gen Ed's? Yes
5. **Are there exceptions: (i.e., a grade of "C" or better in courses which require the "D" course as a pre-requisite, or a C or higher in the last of a course sequence, i.e., Bio I (D), Bio II (D), Bio III (A)- from Quarter System?** No exceptions
6. **What are the requirements for acceptable major courses as identified on the program guide?**
Due to the complexity of Program Sequence choices in the LSHSS major, please refer to the program guide
7. **Will an occasional C be accepted if the GPA is maintained at a 2.500 minimum?** Yes, overall GPA is 2.0 for the LSHSS major
8. **Are P/NC grades accepted in major coursework?** Dependent upon choice of LSHSS Program Sequences
9. **Are 300 level courses transferrable?** Yes, provided the course is a direct equivalent to a LSHSS requirement and the transferable course does not exceed the maximum allowable number of credits permitted for the chosen LSHSS Program Sequence

- 10. What is the total number of credits required for graduation?** 120
- 11. How many credits in the major must be completed at Rowan to graduate?** Dependent upon choice of LSHSS Program Sequences
- 12. What courses, grades, and GPA are needed before applying to the major?** The LSHSS major is open to freshman and transfer students. Minimum GPA is 2.0. Specific courses do not need to be completed prior to becoming a LSHSS major.
