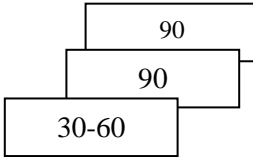

Criteria for Credential Evaluation

1) What is the **maximum number** of transfer credits acceptable? (The residency requirement for a Rowan degree is 30 credits; at least 15 credits in the major.)

a) **Total** transfer credits allowed?
From **4 year** colleges
2 year colleges

b) Do you accept credits from **non-accredited** or Nationally accredited institutions? (Generally, Rowan recognizes regional accreditation.)

Limitations/comments?

Regionally Accredited course work is accepted.
All else is reviewed on a case by case basis, based upon the level of proficiency judged by the entrance portfolio.

Any institution accredited by the National Association of Schools of Art and Design (NASDAD) as having courses equivalent to Rowan are acceptable.

2) What is the **maximum number** of semester hours accepted toward **Art Education/Certification** the major?

BA: 24 s.h. BFA: 63 s.h.

18 s.h. which is 45% of BA Studio Credits, limited to Foundation Studio Art History, and Studio Level I.

Core 12 s.h.

Studio Choices BA: 18 s.h. BFA: 30 s.h.

History/Concepts BA: 9 s.h. BFA 12 s.h.

3) What is the **maximum AGE** of external transfer credits accepted toward the major;

Comments: The above are general guidelines. Specific courses are transferred into a student's program following a portfolio evaluation and in consultation with an Art Department academic advisor.

To receive 3 s.h. for art studio courses, the transfer course must require 6 contact hours. Typically, community college art studio courses have 3 contact hours and will transfer as 1.5 credits of Art Major Elective.
