To qualify for graduation, students must have an overall grade point average of 2.0 and a grade point average of 2.5 in the business core and specialization courses.

- 9) How many credits in the major must be completed at Rowan to graduate?

45-46 s.h. with a minimum of 30 s.h. of Business Courses

- 10) Three credit (3 cr.) Lab Science courses may satisfy the Lab Science requirement. The total credits required for graduation are not to be reduced.

- 11) What courses, grades, and gpa are needed before applying to your major?

An overall Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 and completion of the Rowan equivalent of Statistics I (1702260) and Calculus Techniques and Applications (1701125) or Calculus I (1701130).

**NON-PROGRAM COURSES:**

For Business Administration, the definition is:

Any course offered outside of the College of Business can be identified as a Non-Program Course.

**Only Accounting I&II, Business Law I&II, which equates to Legal Environment, and Principles of Marketing may be accepted from county colleges, others based on review of county college courses.**

**Also, Calculus T&A, Statistics I, Economics I&II, Public Speaking, and Computing Environments must be completed prior to enrollment in upper-level courses.**
