### Criteria for Credential Evaluation

1) What is the maximum number of transfer credits acceptable? (The residency requirement for a Rowan degree is 30 credits; at least 15 credits in the major.)

12 Law and Justice credits are accepted into the degree.

3) What is the maximum AGE of external transfer credits accepted toward your program?

No maximum age limit.

4) Are "D" grades accepted in majors course work?

5) Are P/NC grades accepted in major course work?

Only for Internship courses.

In non-major courses?

Yes

6) Are 300 level or higher level professional courses transferable?

Yes, from 4-year institutions.

7) **What is the total number of credits required for graduation?**

120 s.h.

8) **How many Law/Justice credits must be completed at Rowan**

If from a two-year college, the student must complete 53 credits, including 24 Rowan professional credits.

9) **What is the minimum G.P.A. acceptable in major?**

10) **What courses must be completed to apply?**

**NO specific courses.**

11) **Three credit laboratory courses are accepted for the Lab Science requirement. However, the 1 additional credit must be made up somewhere within the program to produce the needed 120 credits for graduation.**

12) **What are Non-Program Courses within this program?**

Social Problems, (SOC 07.110), American Government (POSC 07.110) or Introduction to Government/Politics (POSC 07.100),

The Logic of Everyday Reasoning (PHIL 09.110) or Philosophy and Society (PHIL 09.241), and Psychology of Scientific Thinking (PSY 01.106)

or Essentials of Psychology (PSY 01.107).

**Comments:** Major requires the following Rowan Experience courses: Public Speaking (CMS 06.202), any 3 credit Rowan experience literature course, any 3 credit Rowan Experience Artistic and Creative Experience course.
