Criteria for Credential Evaluation

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

1) What is the **maximum number** of transfer credits acceptable? (The residency requirement for a Rowan degree is 30 credits; at least 15 credits in the major.)

Seventy-five credits (75), up to 18 in the major. Students must meet the residency requirement (30 cr. Total) and courses must fit within the program guide.

9) What is needed in order to apply?

Transfer students should have sufficient proficiency to enter the major at the Spanish Reading & Conversation (1105.211) or the Spanish Reading and Composition (11053212) level.

10) Are 3 credit Lab Science courses accepted? *YES, if the lab component is clearly verifiable.*

11) What are **Non Program Courses** in this program?

The new General Education model, which goes into effect Fall 2005 for incoming freshmen, has a new bank called "**Non Program Courses**," which replaces the Gen Ed Electives bank. This new bank comprising, **18 credit hours**, can contain any Rowan University course or transfer equivalent —excluding basic skills and courses listed as SPAN and beginning with #1105—, and opens up the Gen Ed model to greater possibilities for the various university minors students may wish to select.

For the Spanish Major Non-Program Courses, we have 6 3-credit ELECTIVES for a total of 18 credits labeled "DIRECTED ELECTIVES" as the Dept. will recommend courses that will help students explore the major.

Comments: GPA: Major (C) Overall (C)

No grade lower than a C- is permitted from among the Spanish courses. One semester of Study Abroad is strongly encouraged.

Transfer students should not expect to complete the program within two years. There is strict adherence to pre-requisites in the major. Spanish majors are required to take one year of a second foreign language. Both courses must be in the same language.
