The purpose of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 is to protect the privacy of individual students by placing restrictions on the disclosure of information contained in a student's university record(s). In many cases at the university level, parents have no inherent right to inspect your education records. However, education records can be released and/or shared by Rowan University to/with your parents with your written consent, or by submission of evidence that the parents have declared you as a dependent on their most recent Federal Income Tax return (according to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, §152).
