BA IN EDUCATION – SPECIALIZATION IN ELEMENTARY EDUCATION PROGRAM GUIDE 4 †In order to earn a BA in Education with Specialization in Elementary Education, candidates must be “Certification Eligible” (i.e., must have earned a BA in one of the following dual majors) [Check one.]:

- American Studies
- English
- Geography
- History
- Liberal Studies: H/SS (with restrictions***)
- Mathematics
- Math/Science
- Spanish
- Writing Arts

+Candidate must be accepted into the BA in Education with Elementary Education Specialization to register for these courses.

***The 60 hours of required Certification courses must be from Liberal Arts and Sciences, Fine and Performing Arts, or Communications. Candidates are encouraged to take courses in the areas in which they will be teaching (i.e., English, Math, Language Arts, Reading, Arts, Science, History, Foreign Language, Government/Civics, Geography, and Economics).**

**** For Certification Purposes, candidates must complete both a Biological and Physical Science Course (one must be a 4 SH Lab).**

***** Humanities/Social Science restrictions: Sequence A—Applied Spanish, Cartography and Geographic Information Systems, English, History, and Political Science; Sequence B—Mathematics, Physical Science: Chemistry, Physical Science: General Chemistry and Physics, Physical Science: Physics, and Physics**

Candidates cannot apply for graduation for the BA in Education with Specialization in Elementary Education or certification without successfully completing all of the requirements needed for the BA in their chosen dual major. Candidates should apply for graduation for both BA degrees at the same time.

In addition to fulfilling the program requirements, all students are required to fulfill the university-wide General Education Requirements and Rowan Experience Requirements.
