

# EOF/MAP Compliance updated 1/26/10

## 1. GPA Requirements: All EOF/MAP students must maintain a **2.0 gpa each** semester.

- 1<sup>st</sup> semester below 2.0 –EOF: Probation
- 2<sup>nd</sup> semester below 2.0- EOF Funding Termination:
  - Removal of EOF funding (\$700 per semester) & loss of sponsorship opportunities.
  - Loss of University EOF scholarship (\$1,000)
  - Funding is not guaranteed once lost. All attempts will be made to reinstate aid upon bringing semester gpa to 2.0 and maintaining all other requirements.
  - Probation/Terminated students will remain on EOF/MAP roster as a non-funded student; maintaining EOF/MAP counseling and resources.

**\*\*\*Failure to meet all other requirements jeopardizes your ability to receive sponsorships to conferences, trips, recommendation letters, book awards, etc...**

## 2. Program Participation Requirements:

### Freshman:

- Fall semester: First Year Seminar
- Spring Semester: 2 workshops
- General Meetings: Fall & Spring Semester
- Monthly meetings with EOF/MAP counselor (or more as designated by counselor)
- Structured Study: 6 hours per week

### Sophomore:

- 2 workshops per semester (Fall/Spring)
- General Meetings: Fall & Spring Semester
- Monthly meetings with counselor
- Structured Study 4 hours per week (if below 2.3gpa)

### Junior- Senior

- General Meetings: Fall & Spring Semester
- 2 meetings per semester with counselor
- Structured Study 4 hours per week (if below 2.3gpa)
- Unless enrolled in an internship/student teaching: Must attend 1 career/graduate school event as determined by student and EOF/MAP counselor (internship/job fair, interview skills, graduate school fair, junior/senior conference, money management, etc..)

## 3. Code of Conduct:

- **Code of Conduct violations with the University and any other behavior deemed unbecoming of a Rowan University EOF/MAP student jeopardizes your funding and/or status as an EOF/MAP student.**
