Description:

A certificate of volunteerism will be given to students who complete 20 hours of service. Attempts will be made to have students serve as ambassadors in their home communities.

Qualifications:

- Must have an in depth understanding of the mission and purpose of EOF/MAP program.
- Comfortable with public speaking and can effectively communicate the benefits of the EOF/MAP program.
- Must have a minimum of 24 credits completed with a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Must be in full compliance with the EOF/MAP program requirements (Workshops, Counseling appointment)
- All pending and past disciplinary matters will be reviewed by the Student Staff Standards Committee for possible disqualification or deferred approval
- Any violation of University policy or local, state and federal laws, while in the application process, may result in disqualification.
