

Using a USB/Flash Drive on a Mac

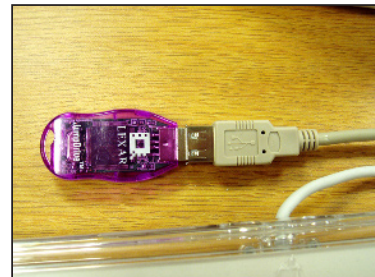
Step 1

Insert your USB/flash drive into the end of the **USB extension cord** attached to the keyboard or the **USB port on your laptop**. **Please note:** It is **not** recommended to insert your USB/flash drive into the USB port on the keyboard because this keyboard does not have enough power to run the mouse and your USB/flash drive at the same time.)

Please allow time for the device to be recognized, approximately 30 seconds, before attempting use.

Step 2

Once inserted, the USB/flash drive icon should appear on your desktop.

Double-click on the icon to access your files.



Step 3

To remove your USB/flash drive, click and drag the USB drive icon to the **Eject icon** in the Dock. (The Trash icon in the Dock turns into the Eject icon as soon as you begin to click and drag the USB/flash drive icon.) Once ejected, the USB/flash drive will no longer be on your desktop.



It is now safe to remove your USB/flash drive from the USB extension cord or USB port.
