## Rowan University Graduation Requirements for all Majors / Degrees

- Students must complete at least 120 semester hours (sh) of coursework that apply to their Rowan University degree.
- Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in Rowan University coursework. (Transfer courses/credits do not count toward the RU GPA)
- A minimum of 30 sh of coursework must be completed at/through Rowan University.
- Grades of C- or better (no D's, F's, or Incompletes) in all general education, dual major Art, core or specialization courses required for the B.A. in Education.
- Students must meet the Rowan Core and Rowan Experience Requirements.
  - An individual course can potentially satisfy one Rowan Core literacy and/or multiple Rowan Experience attributes (i.e., WI, LIT, GLBL and more).

- Students must apply for graduation and should do so for the term in which they will complete all program requirements.

## Program-Specific Graduation Requirements for this Major / Degree

- Students will choose a dual degree in the content area of ART – Art/major program guide for additional course details and program requirements.
- Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 for all professional education and Art major courses. (Only Rowan University courses count toward the cumulative GPA.)
- Grades of "C-" or better in all courses required for B.A. in SME.
- Students must schedule and pass Praxis II (Art - Content Knowledge) exams before admission to Clinical Practice.
- All candidates must meet Transition Points requirements set by the College of Education for Admission to their subject-specific Teacher Preparation program; Admission to Clinical Practice, Graduation, and Application to NJDOE teacher certification.
