

## Water Quality Sampling Schedule

(Update: Oct. 25) Rowan University has been working closely with the N.J. Department of Environmental Protection and private water-quality consultants to develop a comprehensive testing plan for the Glassboro campus. The plumbing study and water testing will help guide the University on developing a plan to address buildings where lead has been found.

Buildings need to be vacant for at least eight hours for testing to occur, which makes drawing samples in academic and administrative buildings much easier than testing the water in residence halls and apartments.

Testing in academic and administrative buildings will occur between Oct. 31 and Nov. 15. Residential buildings will be tested during winter break. Residents will be notified as to the exact date their building will be tested before the end of the semester.
