## MEDICAL SOCIAL SCIENCE MINOR PROGRAM GUIDE

The purpose of the Medical Social Science Minor is to provide students with greater depth in understanding the social factors affecting health behavior, attitudes, and organizations. The Association of American Medical Colleges recognizes the importance of such understanding for pre-medical school students, covering related topics on its Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) entrance exam. There are, however, many health-related careers that do not require medical school nor its heavy reliance on science and math. Such careers include (but are not limited to) allied health, public health and policy, community health organization. The Minor adds to preparation for such careers or for graduate studies leading to such careers.

A total of 21 credits are required to complete the Minor: 9 credits from the Required courses, 12 credits from the Medical Social Science Bank courses.
