Anya Ivanova is studying Psychology at Rowan University, which will be her second bachelor's degree.

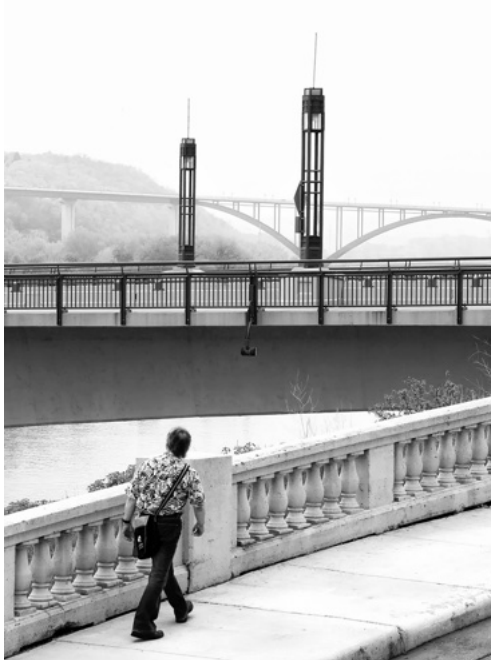
